## DETAILS: NURSERY VOLUNTEER

**Place:** North Cotes College.

**Term:** End of August until end of July (11 months).

**Accommodation:** Single room in the volunteers' apartment on campus.

**Requirements:** Christian, speak English well, experience with young children between 0 and 4 years.

**Assignment:** The nursery volunteer looks after about 15 international children between 0 and 4 years of age. You will work alongside NTM nursery staff and several other volunteers. Each day you will play with the children, teach them new things, read to them, prepare snacks, assist with feeding, change their nappies, and clean the nursery rooms and toys.

**Working hours:** Monday to Friday, 7 hours each.

**Breaks:** one week in October, two weeks around Christmas, one week in February and two weeks around Easter. No breaks can be taken at any other time.

**Other information:** There is a house group for volunteers which you are required to attend each week, on Monday night.

Other volunteer positions include IT, business administration, etc. The jobs are similar to a community service volunteer.

## DETAILS: KITCHEN VOLUNTEER

**Place:** North Cotes College.

**Term:** End of August until end of July (11 months).

**Accommodation:** Single room in the volunteers' apartment on campus.

**Requirements:** Christian, speak English well, experience and interest in cooking and baking.

**Assignment:** The large kitchen provides breakfast and two hot meals a day for about 40 people. It is only closed on Thursday and Sunday evenings. You will work together with the kitchen staff and other volunteers. You will cook main meals, make salads and desserts, bake cakes and bread ... and you can generally be creative. The students are on a rota to help clean up after each meal.

**Working hours:** 5 days a week for about 7 hours each day. The days you work are on rota system and includes working some weekends.

**Breaks:** One week in October, two weeks around Christmas, one week in February and two weeks around Easter. No breaks can be taken at any other times.

**Other information:** There is a house group for volunteers which you are required to attend each week, on Monday night. During the weekdays when you are off you can attend NCC classes; just make sure to ask permission from the teacher first.
